Involving local community radio partners to create awareness about the OSC among the communities



Building capacity of subdistrict health care providers managing in-patient hospitalized emergency COVID-19/ respiratory emergency cases in newborns, adolescents, and women of reproductive age

400 health facilities assessed to understand their preparedness in managing emergency respiratory diseases



Over **1500** Medical Officers (MOs), Staff Nurses (SNs), and Community Health Officers (CHOs) trained
