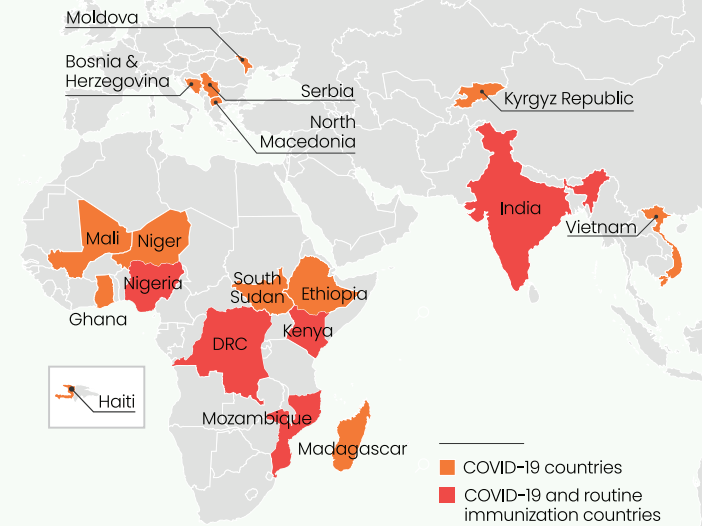

MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity envisions a world in which all people eligible for immunization, from infancy throughout the life-course, and particularly underserved, marginalized, and vulnerable populations, are regularly reached with high-quality vaccination services to protect their children and themselves against vaccine-preventable diseases.

The project is part of an innovative suite of awards funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) to holistically improve health care services, including immunization, in partner countries around the world.



#### WORKING AROUND THE GLOBE

The JSI-led project is a consortium of global leaders that offers technical assistance and applies innovations and best practices to increase equitable immunization coverage in 18 USAID-supported countries around the world. Working at both national and sub-national levels, the project supports countries to reach underserved populations with services that reduce vaccine-preventable diseases.

The project is also contributing to country, regional, and global efforts to reduce the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic through a people-centered approach and alignment between critical program functions supporting immunization. The project is supporting COVID-19 vaccination programs and the strengthening and recovery of routine immunization.
