“Four Corners” activity – statements to read

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FACILITATOR: Select 5-6 of these statements to read during the “Four Corners” activity.

1. A married couple in their mid-20s who wants to delay a third birth should be allowed to do so.
2. An adolescent boy who comes to the drug shop for condoms twice per week should *not* be given condoms.
3. A 25-year-old woman should be able to choose an IUD as her contraceptive method, even if she discloses that she plans to remove it next year.
4. A married man who is suspected of having sex with other men should *not* be given condoms.
5. A disabled man who wants to learn about family planning should be given information and FP commodities.
6. A 15-year-old, in-school, unmarried girl should have accurate and comprehensive information about contraception.
7. An unmarried 19-year-old man with no children should be able to have a vasectomy.
8. A migrant girl working in this area as a domestic worker should not need family planning methods.
9. An adolescent girl living with both of her parents should be given emergency contraception even if her parents may discover it.
